Simple Seizure

- Altered smell, taste, hearing, sight, touch
 - Dizziness
- Tingling or twitching limbs

VS

Complex Seizure

- Staring blankly
- Unresponsive
- Loss of consciousness
 - Repetitive movements

What can trigger a seizure?

 Poor sleep, sickness, stress, bright/flashing lights, caffeine, drugs/alcohol, low blood sugar, certain foods, and more

How can I prevent future seizures?

 Talk to your doctor about medications, keep a journal of your seizures and triggers to avoid, get better sleep, reduce stress

What to do if I witness a seizure occurring?

 Turn the person on their side, remove nearby hard or sharp objects, make sure they can breathe, call 911 if the seizure lasts longer than 5 minutes. Do <u>not</u> try to hold the person down
