
The Zika Virus

What We Know...

- The virus is transmitted through the bite of *Aedes* mosquitos, sexual intercourse or during childbirth
- There is currently no vaccine against Zika virus
- In February 2016, the CDC issued a travel notice to areas with Zika virus, especially for pregnant women
- No local transmission of Zika virus in the U.S. yet, but around 273 U.S. residents have acquired it through travel or sexual intercourse

Should I Be Worried?

If acquired, the virus displays similar symptoms to the flu and are normally mild in nature, lasting 2-7 days. However, Zika infection during pregnancy has been linked to increased risk of miscarriages and birth defects in babies, including microcephaly. The CDC recommends anyone **pregnant** or thinking about becoming pregnant **avoid travel** to areas with active disease.

You Can Prevent the Spread!

Tips if you are traveling to infected areas:

- Avoid mosquito bites
- Sleep with a mosquito net around your bed
- Wear long-sleeved clothing
- Use EPA approved insect repellant
- Use a condom during sexual intercourse
